Treasurer's report. Don presented the treasurer's report. Expenses were higher than normal in June, but CD interest offset it. Also part of June's expense was related to lapsed members, which will be partly reimbursed by National in July. Overall we are financially healthy.

Scholarships: Moved Margaret that we pay \$350 to our local winner, and that we pay for scholarship dinners to our invitees if they show up. Second John. Dinner costs will be paid from regular operations, not the scholarship fund. Passed 6-0.

We discussed uncommitted funds and how much we should keep in that area. No decisions, but we're keeping a watch on how much funds we accumulate and what we do with it. Printer billing: the printer is having issues with billing us properly. Don is working with them to get it fixed.

Circulation: USPS needs a letter on our letterhead specifying Helen as the person in charge of our postal records, and others authorized to see the records (Janet, Don, and John).

We are going to purchase new software for the newsletter. John will handle the order.

Electronic Newsletter Distribution: Helen talked to USPS about electronic distribution. Need to mail 50% plus 1 of the newsletters they produce. Otherwise we will not get penalized by sending newsletters by email.

RG update: Bought easels and easel pads and trays at a garage sale.

Janet adjourned the meeting at 7:20.

#### **August ExComm Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Loc-Sec Janet Kres at 6:05pm. Janet Kres, Don Drumtra, Margaret Wofford, Michael Tolbert and Helen Siders were in attendance.

John Neemidge was out of town.

Janet reported that Claudia Harbert will continue as scholarship chair for 2007. Michelle Vaughn will be the gifted children's co-ordinator. Kathie Blair will serve on the membership committee, which finds candidates and conducts an election each fall for the Lonestar Mensa board members. Michelle will also be a test proctor.

By November, LSM will have new software for use by Editor Rachael Stewart to create our newsletter. The ExCom had budgeted \$1,200 for this expense. John Neemidge has located and will purchase the software for about \$400.

Our planned RG for the Labor Day weekend has a count of 65 pre-registrations. We expect about 100 people.

Janet reported that the LSM monthly meeting will be held on first Mondays (second Monday in Sept) at the North Village Library through July 2007. The earlier news had been that we were ejected because the Austin City Manager had co-opted us for a city meeting. Then Membership chair Mark Kres made a personal visit to the Library staff and, lo and behold, our meeting space was restored. We will be meeting on Mondays instead of Tuesdays.

Nice work, Mark.

Treasurer, Don Drumtra reported that higher than normal ALG printing costs, lower than normal membership support, and our annual scholarship award resulted in an operating loss of \$242.16. Also RG Funds increased to \$5485 with early registrations and RG Registrations Liability increased proportionately. Accounts Payable and Receivable are normal.

Don also serves on a AML committee titled "Local Group Funding Committee", which is looking at revising current procedures for returning part of the Mensan membership fees to local groups, and also to the RVC's. It seems hopeful that AML will not be cutting funding to local groups who decide to offer their members the option of receiving their newsletter via e-mail. Save the trees.

Since our spring picnic was so successful and everybody had such a good time, Helen suggested another picnic in the fall. We selected the date of Sunday October 15. Helen will try and get a reservation at Northwest Park. We will need a picnic co-ordinator.

Thinking ahead to the Christmas party, Helen also agreed to contact Zilker Park and see if any early December Saturday afternoons are available.

Michael Tolbert plans to proctor a Mensan test in his business office on August 12.

Janet adjourned the meeting at 7:00pm.


Ways to help:
