# 2008 January 9 ExComm Monthly Meeting

- 1. Location: Northwest Community Center, 2913 Northland Dr., Austin, TX
- 2. Attending: President: Ron Edelman; Vice-President: Don Drumtra; Treasurer: Patty Drumtra; Members at Large: Janet Kres, Kathie Blair Lawler, and John Neemidge; Circulation Manager: Helen Siders.
- 3. Ron called to order at 6:10 PM.
- 4. Officers Reports:
- 5. Committee Reports:
- a. President: Ron announced his appointment of the officers for 2008 listed on page 2. He expressed disappointment that his announcement messages for the ExComm meeting did not get to the membership before this meeting. Janet moved the president be given authority to send messages directly to the LSM announcement email list without moderation. Kathie seconded and the motion passed unanimously with Ron not voting. John agreed to change the list accordingly. Ron reviewed the LSM December bank statement, selected two checks at random, and compared them with supporting documentation. No discrepancies were found.
- b. V-P: Don moved to confirm the email motion unanimously passed by the ExComm by email on 2007 November 20 to, "Establish an ad-hoc Bylaws Committee charged to draft revisions to the Lonestar Mensa bylaws for approval of the American Mensa Committee and the LSM membership, considering ideas from the membership, the latest American Mensa Bylaws, and Robert's Rules of Order and appoint Don Drumtra Chair. The committee will report their progress to the ExComm monthly and to the Membership through the Armadillo Literary Gazette as appropriate." John seconded. The motion passed unanimously with Ron not voting.
- c. Outgoing Treasurer: Don presented the Outgoing 2007 Treasurer's Report, on page \_\_\_\_\_. Don moved to approve the report, Janet seconded. The motion passed unanimously with Ron not voting.
- d. Incoming Treasurer: Patty presented the Incoming Treasurer's Report proposing the 2008 budget for LSM, page \_\_\_\_\_. Patty moved to approve the 2008 budget as proposed. Don seconded. The motion passed unanimously with Ron not voting.

e. Circulation Manager. Helen reported difficulty with newsletter mailing due to the Post Office implementation of their new Presort Accuracy, Validation, and Evaluation (PAVE) requirements. The AML office staff suggested that it would take a long while before they would be able to provide local groups certified paperwork. Helen reported that she had developed techniques to get our mail accepted in the near term. The sense of the ExComm was that she should continue with her current approach.

## 6. Committee Reports:

- a. 2007 LonestaRG Committee: Don presented the 2007 LonestaRG Treasurer's Report, page\_\_\_. Don moved to approve the report and Kathie seconded. The motion passed unanimously with Ron not voting.
- b. Monthly Bylaws Committee Report. Don reported that the committee has been established and John Neemidge, Lu Russell, Helen Siders, and Steve Skelton have volunteered to participate. If Ron agrees we will consider the committee appointed. Information has been distributed to committee members A Website has been established reporting progress to the members and an article on our status was included in the January 2008, ALG. The first meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 10, 7:15-8:15 PM at Central Market and is open to all members. Future meetings were tentatively scheduled for the first Thursday, of each month same time, same place but were subject to change at the meeting Ron agreed with the appointments.
- 7. Other Business: TGIT. Due to first time attendee complaints of no one at TGIT, the sense of the ExComm was that TGIT should not be listed on the ALG Calendar unless there was someone to host the gathering on behalf of LSM.

# Outgoing 2007 Treasurer's Report

Financially, we had a good year in 2007. As may be seen from the program and balance sheets, overall revenue for all programs except the RG exceeded estimates by 111 percent. This was the result of the dues allocation increase from AML and the great leadership in our recruitment program testing activities. Overall expenses were 80 percent of budget. This is good for the treasury but not as good as an indicator of our programs. We should have done more and spent more. The Lonestar RG also did well as shown in the separate Final RG Financial Report on page . The overall result of our activities in 2008 was a little over \$2,200, providing us a strong position going into 2008. The positive results this year have enabled us to endow future annual scholarships at a base level of \$300 and provide stable resources for the other elements of our Education Program. It will also enable us to provide reasonable support to all programs in 2008. Details of our 2007 finances are provided in the program activity and balance sheet tables.

Thank you for all the support you have given me the past two years. It has been a pleasure serving as our Treasurer and working with the great 2007 ExComm. I look forward to serving as Vice-President and working to make 2008 another great year for us.
