April ExComm Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Lonestar Mensa Executive Committee (ExComm) convened on April 2, 2008, at 6:07 PM, at Northwest Community Center, 2913 Northland Dr., Austin, TX. Attending were: President, Ron Edelstein, as Chairman; Vice-President and Bylaws Committee Chairman, Don Drumtra, as secretary; Treasurer, Patty Drumtra; and Members at Large, Janet Kres, Kathie Blair Lawler, and John Neemidge.

Speaking for the Testing Coordinator Mark Kres, Janet announced that we have testing sessions scheduled for April 15 in Austin, May 3 in Buda, and tentatively, the end of May (for June) in Austin and mid July in Temple.

The Bylaws Committee Chairman, Don, provided the monthly Bylaws Committee report as published in the February Armadillo Literary Gazette, vol. 35, no. 4, page 4. The next Bylaws Committee meeting was scheduled for Thursday, April 10 at Central Market.

The President announced that he planned to provide some additional announcements to members on ongoing events. He reported that on April 2, 2008, he reviewed the March 4, 2008 original bank statement, and compared all transactions with supporting documentation. No discrepancies were found.

The Treasurer provided a report consisting of spreadsheets summarizing program revenue and expenses for March, and the account balances as of March 31. The ExComm adopted the report without debate. She also proposed the financial report for the first quarter, which, after an addition, was adopted as published in the May newsletter. Financial reports are available to members by request. Quarterly reports are published in the Armadillo Literary Gazette.

The meeting adjourned at 6:46 PM.

Bylaws Committee Report

The Bylaws Committee met for the fourth time 7:20-8:20 PM, April 10, 2008, with TGIT, at Central Market. We approved prior work with two exceptions and continued work on the ideas and questions that we need to answer. The minutes and other details of our work are posted our Website, http://www.ischool.utexas.edu/ ~drumtra/website/LSMBylaws/

More specifically, the committee approved correcting the spelling of the local group name to "Lone Star Mensa," and reconsidering the formula for determining the number of Members-at-Large on the Board. It also approved a three level structure of local group officers consisting of the Board, four standing committees and three annual ad hoc committees, and the committee members. The standing committees areas of responsibility will be: recruitment, membership, testing etc.; communications, newsletter, website, advertizing, email lists, etc.; education, scholarship awards, gifted children, gifted teens, etc.; and symposia, monthly meetings, social activities, etc. The committee chairs will be members of the Board with limited voting privileges. There will also be a small number of independent officers such as the Ombudsman some of whom require national office approval.

At our next meeting we plan to take up questions like the term of office for the Board and its members, how officers are elected or appointed, and titles of officers. Come help. The next meeting will be 7:15-8:15 PM, Thursday, May 8, at Central Market with TGIT. The meetings are open and all may attend.



Treasurer's Report - First Quarter 2008

I am able to report that Lonestar Mensa was in sound financial condition with revenue greater than expenses at the end of the first quarter. We need to particularly thank Mark Kres and his inspiration Janet as well as Ellen Lukasik for testing 13 prospective members, providing much needed revenue to our Recruitment Program. As may be seen from the tables, except for the Communications Program, expenses during the first quarter were significantly below budget indicating that we could do more with our money. One problem on the horizon lies with our CD interest income that is expected decrease from 4.91% to 3.11%, potentially impacting our Education program revenue. Hopefully revenue from our RG this year will offset this decrease. The Lonestar Executive Committee approved this report on April 2, 2008.


