The list of winners has arrived for this year's Mensa Education & Research Foundation scholarship contest. Lonestar Mensa had another successful scholarship contest this year!

National Mensa promises us one local scholarship winner. This year, that honor goes to Pete Karagozian III, a high school student at Cedar Park High School, who is planning to study medicine. Lonestar Mensa also had two winners at the National level! Kyle Goyette is studying for a PhD in History at Texas State University. He is focusing on the influence of the Equal Rights Amendment on political culture in Texas. Kyle won an award from National Mensa for a top-quality essay. Alexis Avram is studying aerospace engineering at UT. Alexis won the David Mann Scholarship for Study of Aeronautical Engineering or an Aerospace Field, one of 5 scholarships of \$1000, the highest amount awarded by the Mensa Foundation!

Their top-rated entries competed at the Regional and then National levels. The essays our judges chose apparently appealed to the Regional and National judges, too! #### May ExComm Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Lonestar Mensa Executive Committee (ExComm) convened on May 6, 2009 at 6:05 PM, at Northwest Community Center, 2913 Northland Dr., Austin, TX. Attending were: President Ron Edelstein Chairman, Vice-President Don Drumtra Secretary, Treasurer Patty Drumtra, Membersat-Large Paul Anderson and John Neemidge, Circulation Manager Helen Siders, and Programs Officer Mike Makuch. The ExComm approved without debate the April 1 ExComm minutes published in the May Armadillo Literary Gazette (ALG) page 6 with the correction of the meeting date to 2009 and the Membership Committee abbreviation.

Ron announced that he had appointed Frederick Goertz as Membership Committee Chair and Mike Makuch as Programs Officer (Meetings Coordinator). He also announced that he had reviewed the original checking account statement for February, March, and April 2009 comparing all checks written against the supporting documentation in the Treasurer's books, and determined that there were no discrepancies or errors in supporting documentation.

Patty reported that the group was currently in good health; however, the 20 percent drop in membership will result in decreased revenue, which might require budget adjustments. The ExComm adopted the report without debate. Financial reports are available to members online and by request. Quarterly reports are also published in the ALG.

Don reported for the Membership Committee (Mem-Comm) that Fred had discussed lapsed member procedures with the AML National Office (NO). He planned to contact lapsed members and invite them to renew their membership. Mike suggested that it might be useful to ask members who have not renewed why they did not and perhaps combine efforts with Fred. The Ex-Comm encouraged Fred and Mike to work together on this. A testing session was scheduled for June.

John reported for the Communications Committee (ComComm) that there are still vacant positions on the committee, that no feed back has been received from the change of the newsletter article submission date to the second Thursday beginning in June, and that alias addresses and email lists have been updated and are available for use. John agreed to send the list to the Ex-

Comm members. Helen presented member comments to the ExComm on suggestion to email newsletter links to the membership (rather than sending a PDF file). The ExComm debated the decision process surrounding such changes. It was the sense of the ExComm that the ComComm should have been involved in the decision process and that the ComComm should carefully consider the pros and cons of such changes before agreeing to implement them.

Mike reported for the Symposia Committee (SymComm) that programs have been confirmed for through August and that he was exploring ways to get feedback from members on what sort of programs they would be most interested in. He reminded members of the picnic on May 30.

Don reported for the Education Committee (EdComm) that the national scholarship award winners should be announced in May and that the LSM winner would be announced shortly after that.

Don, Bylaws Committee Chair, reported that there was not a quorum at the April 9 Bylaws Committee meeting. The report was published in the May ALG page 5. He also submitted the report provided in this ALG that the committee completed the draft bylaws at a special meeting April 27 and recommended ExComm approval of the draft bylaws for submission to the AMC Bylaws Committee. The ExComm adopted the recommendation without debate.

The LonestaRG Committee had no report.

Don moved that the ExComm adopt four ASIEs previously discussed: ASIE 2009-4 on TGIT dates; ASIE 2009-5 on The LSM News Cycle; ASIE 2009-6 amending on LSM Member Speakers at Monthly Meetings; and ASIE 2009-xx on Website Information Availability. The ExComm adopted the first three without debate and tabled the fourth until the next meeting due to lack of time for debate. The ASIEs are available on the LSM Website.

Don announced the next regular monthly ExComm meeting was scheduled for 6-7 PM, Wednesday, June 3 at the Northwest Recreation Center multipurpose room. ExComm meetings are open and all Mensa members may attend.

At 7 PM the ExComm adopted a motion to extend the meeting 20 minutes. It adjourned at 7:20 PM.

#### From the RVC

Now that all the campaigning is over and this year's National and International Elections are history, it's time to look forward to the Annual Gathering. If you have never been to an AG, you cannot imagine what an experience it can be. Think of the best Mensa activity you have ever attended, then multiply it by at least a factor of 10. If you've never been to a Regional Gathering, multiply it by 100. Think of it: 2000 of your fellow Ms all together in one place for 4 days! If you can't get away for the AG in Pittsburgh this year, you can start planning now to go to next year's AG in Michigan. Speakers, games, workshops, art, music, all kinds of entertainers, banquets, tours, non-stop hospitality... what more could one ask?

Well, actually, there is one more thing I could ask for - extending the party for another few days! On a more serious note, some of you may be aware that American Mensa recently concluded a long-running lawsuit over unauthorized use of our name. While the jury did not choose to award us any damages, they did confirm our legal rights to use of our name and the British company we sued has changed the name of their product to eliminate the alleged infringement. If you have further questions about this litigation, a Q&A section has been posted on the AML website.

To give it a try, log on www.us.mensa.org/profileup-date. You can enter UserID (member nbr or your email address) and Psw. First, if your email address is not current, update it! Then look for the phrase 'electronic publications, if available.' Then set the switch to enable the electronic distribution of your newsletter and other publications. There will be a one to two month lag before the arrival of your first electronic newsletter.

We approved previous work the committee had done, completed work on Articles VI - Elections and XIII -Bylaws Amendments, and recommended that the ExComm approve the Proposed Bylaws as an amendment to our current bylaws for submission to the AMC Bylaws Committee. Finally, the committee adjourned the meeting at the call of the chair for possible future meetings to address questions or changes from the AMC review. Please join me in thanking all Lonestar Mensa members who provided input and other support during the Bylaws development process and particularly the Bylaws Committee members for all their hard work and hours of meetings to complete the project.
