

By the time most of you read this, North Texas Mensa's Regional Gathering will be history, but if you're still thinking about going to your first RG, you'll be glad to know that Gulf Coast Mensa is planning their 2010 RG for the usual Memorial Day Weekend dates in Houston. If you've never been to an RG, you owe it to yourself to try at least one. A whole 3-day weekend surrounded by scores of your fellow Mensans – it's an experience like no other. Games, contests, eclectic programs, usually a dance or two, and a spacious hospitality suite where you can just hang out with interesting people and make new friends; and when you can't keep your eyes open any longer, you just take a short elevator ride to your room and rest up for the next day's festivities. Don't worry about being in a group of strangers; if you don't know anyone when you arrive, you certainly will by the time the first day is over. The only thing better than spending a weekend with a hundred or more Mensa members is spending one with a couple of thousand at the Annual Gathering, and speaking of the AG...

I'm still working on the "MensaTrain" to the AG next summer, and responses are still trickling in. If you think you might be interested, it's not too late to e-mail me at the special reply address: AGTrain@region6.us.mensa. org and let me know where you would be boarding and whether you would prefer coach or sleeper (see my September column for route and schedule information, or go to www.amtrak.com and look up the Texas Eagle route). I should have more information for everyone right after the first of the year.

And, it's probably not too late to join the Mensa cruise out of Galveston, March 7-14, 2010, to Cozumel, the Costa Maya, and Roatan, Honduras. Deposits (\$500 per cabin) were due by Nov. 21, but at the time of writing it looks like we will make our minimum, and after that we can add additional cabins at the same rate as long as space is available. The cost, depending on accommodation, will be a mere \$580 to \$730 per person, double occupancy, including all fees and taxes. Don't have a roomie? November ExComm Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Lonestar Mensa Executive Committee (ExComm) convened at 6:00 PM, November 4, 2009, at the Northwest Community Center, 2913 Northland Dr., Austin, TX. Attending were: President Ron Edelstein Chairman; Vice-President Don Drumtra Secretary; Treasurer Patty Drumtra; Members-at-Large Paul Anderson, Kathie Lawler, and John Neemidge, Membership Chair Fred Goertz, and LSM members Helen Siders and Kelly Walraven. The ExComm adopted without debate the agenda and the September 9 ExComm minutes published in the September Armadillo Literary Gazette (ALG) page 7.

Don reported that the ExComm did not adopt an email motion to hold 2010 monthly meetings on the Second Tuesdays at the North Village Branch Library.

Ron announced that there were no officer changes in October.

Patty reported that at the end of October that LSM is in good financial health. The ExComm adopted the report without debate. Financial reports are available to members on the LSM Website and by request; quarterly are also published in the ALG.

Kathie, Communications Chair, reported that the last mailing went well but there were delays in getting the newsletter to Austin for review on time. She will be checking on it.

Don reported for the Education Committee that Mensa scholarship applications were being accepted and that announcements were sent to various schools and would be available at the monthly meeting. He passed out copies of the announcement at the meeting.

Fred reported that LSM needs a proctor coordinator and several proctors to maintain its testing program.

Ron reported for the Symposia Committee that there will be a picnic honoring new members on November 7 and the December general meeting will be the annual Christmas Party scheduled for December 12. The Ex-Comm adopted a motion to reduce the cost to \$5.00 per person payable at the door with the SymCom picking up any remaining cost. Soft drinks, beer, and wine will be available. The ExComm approved a reimbursement of \$114.24 in support of the Halloween party.

John, LonestaRG 2009 Chair, advised that his report

was not yet completed.

John also reported that LonestaRG 2010 participation remained at 22 registrations and \$800. LSM is desperately in need of an RG chair.

The ExComm adopted a Standing Rule (ASIE) to hold 2010 membership meetings on the second Wednesday of each month at the North Village Branch Library and a Standing Rule to hold TGITs on the second, and fourth Thursdays at Central Market North and the third Thursday at Central Market South except on holidays.

Since the Northwest Recreation Center is closing for renovation in 2010, the ExComm considered holding the 2010 ExComm meetings 6:00 to 6:50 PM at Souper Salad on Anderson Lane before the general meeting. The V-P agreed to draft a standing rule with specific dates and time for consideration at the next meeting.

Don announced the next regular monthly ExComm meetings were scheduled for 6-7 PM, December 2 (the first Wednesday), at the Northwest Recreation Center multipurpose room. ExComm meetings are open and all Mensa members may attend. The meeting adjourned at 6:55 PM.
